

LEAD AWARENESS TRAINING COURSE: (2 HOURS)

This training course is mandatory for workers occupants who may be exposed to lead hazards while occupying buildings. The training satisfies the requirements outlined in 40 CFR 745 and 29 CFR 1926.62. The topics covered in the training include the following:

1. Information regarding lead and its various sources and forms.
2. Information on the health effects associated with Lead exposure. Medical monitoring.
3. Sources of lead hazards throughout buildings.
4. Recognition of damage, deterioration, and delamination of Lead Containing Paint.
5. Lead hazard assessment.
6. Proper handling procedures of Lead hazards. Safety and Health hazards.
7. Proper use of Personal Protective Equipment.
8. Respirator Training: Respirator Program and Respirator use and maintenance.
9. Air and Wipe sampling and analytical methods
10. Proper packaging, disposal, cleanup and decontamination procedures.
11. Record keeping
